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#### EXECUTIVE POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (EPAC) \*OPEN TO CEOS ONLY\*

Responsible for the strategic direction and oversight of ACH's policy priorities, oversight of all policy and advocacy initiatives, and five subcommittees. After completing a term, CEOs become eligible to join the ACH Board of Directors.

#### FINANCIAL SUSTAINABILITY SUBCOMMITTEE

Develops policies and strategies to maximize the amount of funding Congress provides through 330 grants and other discretionary programs and identifies funding opportunities either not utilized or underutilized in CHC funding streams.

#### EMERGING ISSUES SUBCOMMITTEE

Supports health centers today and prepares them for tomorrow — addressing natural disasters, infrastructure challenges, and other emergencies, while advancing the latest innovations in care delivery

#### MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

Supports ACH's membership retention and growth goals by reviewing membership levels and criteria, brainstorming membership initiatives, and identifying ways to enhance member support.

#### PROGRAMS COMMITTEE

Provides feedback on current program offerings at ACH, ensuring alignment with ACH's mission, as well as brainstorming new program offerings and activities that would be of benefit to ACH members.

#### WORKFORCE COMMITTEE

Tackles the biggest challenges facing CHC staff, develops solutions, and collaborates with policymakers to bring them to life. Members create strategies to build a skilled, resilient workforce ready to meet the evolving needs of CHCs.
