Review Criteria - ACH Staff will evaluate all abstract submissions on the following criteria, for a maximum of 100 points per submission.

CRITERIA CATEGORIES	POINTS
Financial Sustainability <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does the abstract highlight ways to optimize savings, new revenue sources, or cost-cutting measures for health centers?• Are the best practices proposed within this submission sustainable and able to cover their costs or have a nominal impact over time?	20 Points Maximum
Innovation: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Are the planned best practices innovative, new, or a new application within primary care and/or community health care?• Is the abstract proposing a new or innovative approach within the community health center program?• Are new platforms, techniques, or technologies utilized or discussed within this abstract?	30 Points Maximum
Impact: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What measurable impact does the submission have with regards to patient outcomes, patient numbers, or those of providers, or other statistics?• Does the submission's impact provide a scalable / replicable blueprint for implementation at other health centers?	25 Points Maximum
Relevance <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What is the demonstrated interest from current ACH members with regards to the proposal's topic?• Are the discussed topics timely with regards to ongoing legislation or conversations in the primary care space?	20 Points Maximum
Proposal Clarity: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Is the proposal detailed, well-written, and present a cohesive description of the best practice?	5 Points Maximum
