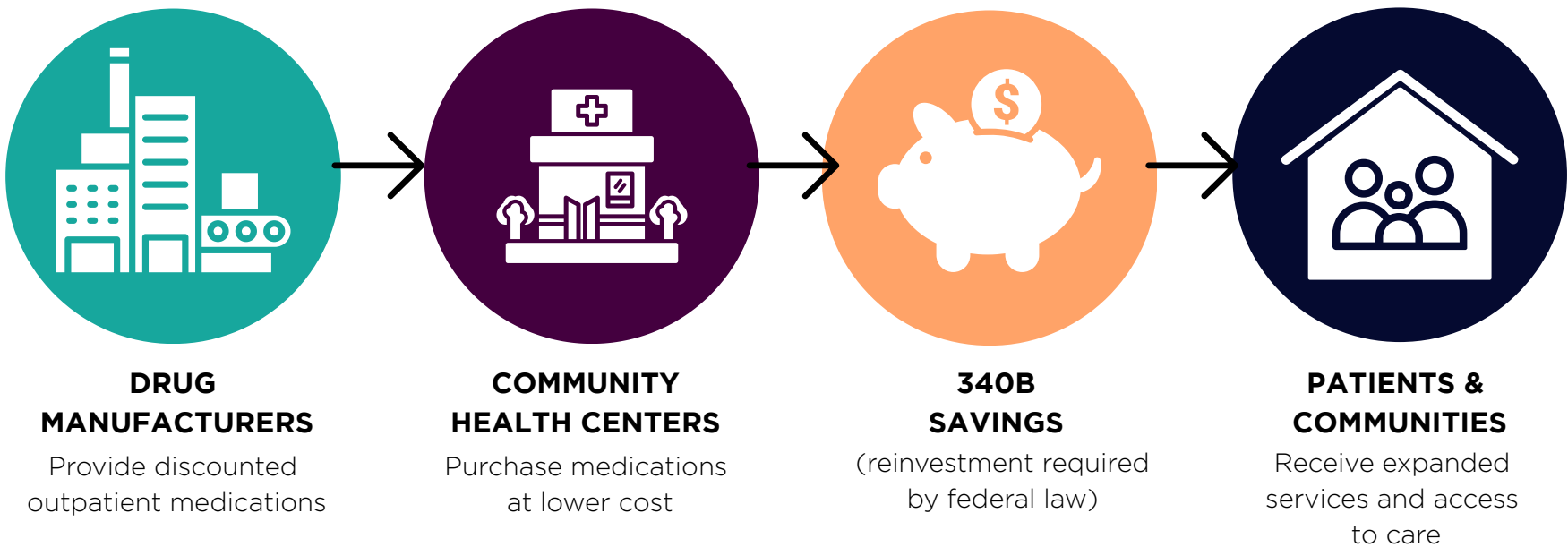




What is the 340B Drug Pricing Program?

A vital tool that helps community health centers stretch limited healthcare dollars.

HOW IT WORKS



EVERY DOLLAR SAVED MUST BE REINVESTED
Federal law requires health centers to use 100% of 340B savings to support patient care and health center operations.

340B SAVINGS HELP HEALTH CENTERS:

 KEEP CLINICS OPEN especially in rural and underserved communities	 EXPAND MOBILE CLINICS AND TELEHEALTH SERVICES	 INCREASE ACCESS TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTHCARE
 EXPAND DENTAL AND SPECIALTY CARE	 PROVIDE AFFORDABLE MEDICATIONS FOR UNINSURED AND UNDERINSURED PATIENTS	 OFFSET INADEQUATE MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT

WHY IT MATTERS

Community health centers rely on three primary funding sources:

1. Section 330 Health Center Grants
2. Medicaid reimbursement
3. 340B Savings



As federal funding and Medicaid reimbursement have not kept pace with the cost of care, 340B is increasingly critical for maintaining access to care.

ACCOUNTABILITY

- ✓ Health centers are required to reinvest 340B savings into patient care and health center operations
- ✓ ACH supports strong transparency and accountability to ensure the program serves patients as Congress intended.
